Notice is hereby given that on Tuesday the 14th day of May, 2024 at the usual polling places in the election precincts of Sherman County, Nebraska, a Primary Election will be held pursuant to Nebraska Statute 32-802. The polls will open at 8:00a.m. and close at 8:00p.m. Said election will be for nominating candidates to various offices or in cases electing candidates to various offices. Some races will not appear on the Primary Election ballot as the number of candidates filing for office did not exceed twice the number of vacancies; these candidates are declared nominated and will advance to the November 5, 2024 General Election. The County Clerk shall place the names of such automatically nominated candidates on the General Election ballot.
