

Sherman County Board of Commissioners

The Sherman County Board of Commissioners met in regular session on Monday, April 27, 2026, in the Boardroom of the Sherman County Courthouse with the following persons present: Tom Bandur-Chairman, Kenneth Kaslon-Vice Chairman, and David Siegel. Also, present was Sasha Habe- Sherman County Clerk. The Chairman called the meeting to order at 9:00a.m. Notice of the meeting was published in the Sherman County Times and given in advance to all members of the Board. At the beginning of the meeting, the Chairman announced and informed the public that a current copy of the Open Meeting Act was posted on the South wall of the Boardroom with copies of the Act also available in the Boardroom for public viewing.

Those present recited the Pledge of Allegiance.

The Board reviewed the minutes of April 8, 2026, regular meeting. An agenda was posted in the Clerk's office and kept continuously current. Motion by Kaslon and seconded by Siegel to approve the previous minutes as written with proof of publication on file. Roll Call Vote: Ayes: Bandur, Kaslon, Siegel. Nays: None. Absent: None. Motion carried.

Public Comment- Jacie Bandur discussed possible events on the courthouse lawn each month as part of the Visioning 2030 plans.

The Board reviewed the mail received, the claims submitted for payment, and the Library Board, Bowmans and Region 26 minutes.

- Joel Bergman-Sherman County Sheriff, monthly updates.
- Joyce Goc discussed with the board her concerns if part of Pool Road would be closed, such as access to her mail and trash.
- Dustin Will with Benefits Management went over health and dental insurance proposal and presented packets to the Board.
- Laura Hart-City of Loup City Mayor presented the Board with a one-year interlocal agreement to review.

- Motion by Bandur and seconded by Kaslon for the Board to go into closed session at 10:02a.m. with Mitch Dzingle-Noxious Weed Superintendent, to prevent harm to the reputation of an individual, retirement timeline. Roll Call Vote: Ayes: Bandur, Kaslon, Siegel. Nays: None. Motion carried. The Board returned to regular session at 10:27a.m.
- Motion by Bandur and seconded by Siegel to approve Chairman Bandur to sign Interlocal Cooperation Agreement with Region 26. Roll Call Vote: Ayes: Kaslon, Bandur, Siegel. Nays: None. Absent: None. Motion carried.
- Motion by Bandur and seconded by Kaslon to approve Chairman Bandur to sign Resolution 09-26 to reaffirm and commit to continued participation with Region 26. Roll Call Vote: Ayes: Siegel, Kaslon, Bandur. Nays: None. Absent: None. Motion carried.
- Don Shuda- Veterans Service Office went over the benefits and cost savings offered to the Veterans in Sherman County. He went over what the 3% increase asking would be covering and stated it was voted on and approved by the committee. Motion by Kaslon and seconded by Siegel to approve renewal with Veterans Services with a 3% increase. Roll Call Vote: Ayes: Kaslon, Siegel, Bandur. Nays: None. Motion carried.
- Motion by Siegel and seconded by Kaslon to table reappointment of Duane Meith to the Sherman County Veteran Committee to the next regular board meeting on May 27, 2026 to allow time for the committee to get in contact with him regarding the reappointment. Roll Call Vote: Ayes: Bandur, Kaslon, Siegel. Nays: None. Motion carried.
- Chairman Bandur noted proof of publication of Notice to Bidders and at 11:36a.m. opened the sealed bid submitted for the tree removal at the courthouse and read aloud. After discussion, motioned by Siegel and seconded by Kaslon to accept the low bid submitted by Gidley's Tree Service in the amount of \$1,900. Roll Call Vote: Ayes: Siegel, Bandur, Kaslon. Nays: None. Motion carried.
- Chairman Bandur noted proof of publication of Notice to Bidders and at 11:38a.m. opened the sealed bid submitted for the sidewalk project 2026 at the courthouse and read aloud. After discussion, motioned by Bandur and seconded by Kaslon to accept the low bid submitted by F&A Concrete Finish LLC in the amount of \$22,800. Roll Call Vote: Ayes: Kaslon, Bandur, Siegel. Nays: None. Motion carried.
- Motion by Kaslon and seconded by Bandur to approve the claims submitted for payment. Roll Call Vote: Ayes: Siegel, Kaslon, Bandur. Nays: None. Absent: None. Motion carried.

- General road business was discussed with Eric Person-Highway Superintendent.
- Chairman Bandur directed the Highway Superintendent to do a road study on Pool Road south of Hwy 92.
- The Board discuss selling parcel ID 300017900, fuel barrel site in Rockville, but after farther discuss they decided to keep it.

- Kyle Anderson-Planning and Zoning Administrator presented an amended zoning permit fee schedule that would increase the permit rates as recommended, approved, and voted on by the committee. Motion by Kaslon and seconded by Siegel to approve the new Zoning Fee Schedule. Roll Call Vote: Ayes: Siegel, Kaslon, Bandur. Nays: None. Absent: None. Motion carried.
