Sherman County Board of Commissioners

The Sherman County Board of Commissioners met in regular session on Wednesday, April 8, 2026, in the Boardroom of the Sherman County Courthouse with the following persons present: Tom Bandur-Chairman, Kenneth Kaslon- Vice Chairman and David Siegel. Also, present was Sasha Habe-Sherman County Clerk. The Chairman called the meeting to order at 9:00a.m. Notice of the meeting was given by advanced publication in the Sherman County Times, given in advance to all members of the Board. At the beginning of the meeting, the Chairman announced and informed the public that a current copy of the Open Meeting Act was posted on the South wall of the Boardroom with copies of the Act also available in the Boardroom for public viewing. Those present recited the Pledge of Allegiance.

The Board reviewed the minutes of March 24, 2026, regular meeting. An agenda was posted in the Clerk's office and kept continuously current. Motion by Siegel and seconded by Kaslon to approve the previous minutes as written with proof of publication on file. Roll Call Vote: Ayes: Bandur, Kaslon, Siegel. Nays: None. Motion carried.

Kaslon talked about Region 3 budget preparation.

The Board reviewed the mail received, the monthly reports of the County Clerk, Sheriff, Attorney and Clerk of the District Court, Treasurer's revenue listing by fund, Region 26 minutes and Library Minutes.

- Motion by Bandur and seconded by Kaslon to cancel check No. 20242867 payable to Carolyn Sekutera for prior services. Roll Call Vote: Ayes: Siegel, Kaslon, Bandur. Nays: None. Motion carried.
- Motion by Kaslon and seconded by Siegel to cancel check No. 20242962 payable to Shorty's Repair: duplicate payment. Roll Call Vote: Ayes: Kaslon, Siegel, Bandur. Nays: None. Motion carried.
- **Opening of Sealed Fertilizer Bids for the Courthouse for the year of 2026** Chairman Bandur noted proof of publication of Notice to Bidders and at 10:09a.m. opened the sealed bid submitted for fertilizing the courthouse and read aloud. After discussion, motioned by Bandur and seconded by Kaslon to accept the bid submitted by Kingpin Fertilizing in the amount of \$1,835. Roll Call Vote: Ayes: Bandur, Kaslon, Siegel. Nays: None. Motion carried.
- **Opening of Sealed Mowing Bids for Bowman Lake Recreation Area for 2026** Chairman Bandur noted proof of publication of Notice to Bidders and at 10:17a.m. opened the sealed bids submitted for the mowing of Bowman Lake Recreation Area for the 2026 season and read aloud. After discussion, motioned by Bandur and seconded by Siegel to accept the low bid submitted by Kaslon Lawn Care LLC for the 2026 mowing season in the amount of \$370 per mowing. Roll Call Vote: Ayes: Siegel, Bandur. Nays: None. Abstain: Kaslon. Motion carried.

The board took a break at 10:30A.M. till 10:45A.M.

DISCUSSION

- Sasha informed the board that she reached out to Applied Connective Technology to get recommendation for a backup internet since there has been issues with the internet going out. Applied Connective Technology and Sasha got in touch with FirstNet about options for back up internet. FirstNet sent out a demo router to see how the equipment would work within the courthouse. Sasha will plan to work with the other offices and Applied Connective Technology to execute testing of the equipment and report back to the board on how it went.
- The board reviewed Rus Goc easement and agreed to close a portion of Pool Road behind Rus Goc's home with allowing Joyce Goc access to her home. After the easement is signed by the parties involved the board will proceed with closing the road.
- The board discussed possibly selling parcel ID 300019700 but will need to discuss with the highway superintendent if the road department is using said parcel.
