Sherman County Commissioners

The Sherman County Board of Commissioners met in regular session on Wednesday, August 12, 2026, in the Boardroom of the Sherman County Courthouse with the following persons present: Tom Bandur-Chairman, Kenneth Kaslon- Vice Chairman and David Siegel. Also, present was Sasha Habe-Sherman County Clerk and Scott Mrcozek and Darnell Janulewicz. Chairman Bandur called the meeting to order at 9:02am and announced the Open Meetings Act posted on the south wall. Notice of the meeting was given by advanced publication in the Sherman County Times, a copy of proof of publication was given to the Board. Those present recited the Pledge of Allegiance.

The Board reviewed the minutes from the July 28, 2026, regular meeting. Motion by Kaslon and seconded by Siegel to approve the minutes. Roll Call Vote: Ayes: Bandur, Kaslon, Siegel. Nays: None. Motion carried.
