The Sherman County Board of Commissioners met in regular session on Tuesday, July 28, 2026, in the Boardroom of the Sherman County Courthouse with the following persons present: Tom Bandur-Chairman, Kenneth Kaslon- Vice Chairman and David Siegel. Also, present was Sasha Habe-Sherman County Clerk and Darnell Janulewicz. Chairman Bandur announced the Open Meetings Act posted on the south wall. Notice of the meeting was given by advanced publication in the Sherman County Times, a copy of proof of publication was given to the Board. Those present recited the Pledge of Allegiance.
